Use the play dough from the recipe below to create your own snow man friend with the parts we have included - a top hat, wiggly eyes, carrot nose, ribbon scarf, buttons to put down their front, and pipe cleaner arms. Use all of the parts, some of them, or none. Use your imagination to make your own unique snowman.

Play Dough

2 1/2 c. flour 2 c boiling water
1/2 c salt 3 Tbsp oil
2 pkg. Kool-Aid
Mix all ingredients together. Let stand until cool enough to handle. Store in an airtight container.
