## **Tuition and Fundraising Requirements**

- I. The estimated cost of educating a child at the School of St. Philip for 2023-2024 is \$7,168.70. If parents are able to pay this in full, they are welcome to do so. However, through our parish subsidy, gifts, and bequests, we are able to offer parents a lower tuition fee accompanied by a fundraising requirement.
- II. **Tuition:** The required amount of tuition for the 2023-2024 school year for children in Kindergarten—Grade 5 is set at **\$2,990 per student**.
- III. **Fundraising:** All families sending their child or children to the School of St. Philip must agree to pay the set tuition and actively participate in the marathon fundraiser, the Scrip program, and other fundraisers as needed to bring in \$1,300.00 above their tuition payment. If parents prefer not to participate in actively pursuing the fundraising obligation, they may pay the set tuition and an annual fundraising obligation of \$1,300.00. In addition to the Tuition and Fundraising requirements, families are charged a per student Material Fee of \$110.00 (If paid by May 26, 2023 the fee is \$70.00).
- IV. Scholarship Opportunities: The School of St. Philip believes that every child be given the opportunity to be enrolled in our school. To help make this possible, each parent will be given the opportunity to apply for Scholarship Assistance to assist them in meeting their specific tuition obligations. Scholarship applications need to be submitted with this contract.
- V. **Tuition Credits** In addition to scholarships there are credits available to help offset the cost for families with more than one K-5 student enrolled in our school. A second child and third child credit of \$500 each is available.
- VI. **Materials Fee:** In addition to the Tuition and Fundraising requirements, families are charged a per student Material Fee of \$110.00 (If paid by May 26, 2023 the fee is \$70.00).

There are three Tuition Payment Plans available:

Plan I: Total tuition is paid in full in August.

Plan II: Special payment schedule set up with Parish Administrator.

Plan III: Monthly automatic withdrawal from your bank account or credit card options on a 12 month, 10 month or 9 month basis.
